Features

- the building is cast-in-place concrete, with structural steel and concrete on metal deck for the mezzanine
- the façade is precast concrete panels with casement windows and curtainwall at the 20th and 21st floors with large windows providing abundant natural light
- the building features 22 levels above grade and two below, with 52 apartments: 8 1BR units; 24 2BRs; 12 3BRs; 2 3 BR duplexes; 4 4BRs; and 2 5BR duplexes
- high-end finishes include Valcucine kitchen cabinets
- two duplex penthouses offer wraparound decks and barbecues
- a landscaped terrace on the second floor podium roof provides plantings, seating areas and pergolas
